
## Parking in Hutton Village Centre

Further to our report in the Autumn edition of Hutton News.

A meeting took place on 27th September 2017

Councillor Keith Iddon who is responsible for highways in Lancashire, along with two LCC officers listened to concerns with regard to road safety raised by Hutton and South Ribble Councillors. Our major concern is inconsiderate parking which affects road safety in the Village centre. Following a very constructive meeting with the representatives of LCC HPC were advised that the Parish clerk would receive a report on their findings in approximately five weeks from the date of the meeting. In an attempt to encourage car drivers to use the Village car park and park Responsibly, HPC has ordered 3 new signs showing the location of the car park. Two of the signs will be located on either side of Liverpool Road at its junction with Moor Lane. The 3rd sign will be located at the entrance to the car park. It is expected that these signs will be erected before the end of the year. 200 flyers encouraging car drivers to park responsibly have been circulated and also displayed in Council notice boards.
