PARISH COUNCIL NEWS

At the last meeting of the Council it was decided that the Parish Council would fund the creation of a path from the access road just behind the Village Hall to the wildlife area at the bottom of the recreation ground. The path which will be disabled friendly will allow easy access to the area which has developed well since it was first created a few years ago. A bench and hard standing will now be incorporated at the far end to allow people to rest and take in the peaceful surroundings.

The existing planters located next to the war memorial, which were gifted to the Council some years ago, are now well past their best and are to be replaced as soon as possible with similar bespoke planters. A contractor has been appointed and the work will commence as soon as practicable and hopefully in time for this year's Remembrance Service.

It was also decided that an approach should be made to Lea and Cottam Parish Council to utilise their SPID device in 3 locations in Hutton, rather than having to buy a new device. Lea and Cottam Parish Council will manage the device as part of their own set up, although brackets will need to be installed by Hutton PC, locations agreed with LCC and poles erected at the agreed locations on Lindle Lane, Ratten Lane and Liverpool Road as required. This arrangement will be for a trial period of 12 months which will enable us to look at the resultant figures and decide whether to continue the arrangements into the future.
