## **PUBLIC CONSULTATION RESULTS**

The results of the public consultation, held late last year, on how best to spend the £30,000 of available funds from the Community Infrastructure Levy have now been analysed. Many thanks to all who submitted ideas and comments.

The suggestions are wide-ranging and each and every one has been considered and, where possible, allocated to the most appropriate route for consideration of action. Many actually relate to initiatives the Parish Council are already pursuing either independently or in conjunction with other bodies.

The area around the village hall - the pond, children's playground, disused tennis courts, recreation ground and wildlife area - is where the largest number, of those who responded, wish to see improvements. The Parish Council are currently working with other interested parties to explore what might be achieved.
