A LOCAL HISTORIAN SHARES THIS INTERESTING STORY ABOUT ONE OF THE SOLDIERS NAMED ON OUR HUTTON WAR MEMORIAL

Donald Anthony Gee, known as Tony, was born on 23rd January 1920, in Wigan, the eldest child whose younger brother died in infancy. He was thus an only child.

His father resided in Wigan but his parents married in Nottingham in 1919, and subsequently moved to the detached bungalow at 13 Tolsey Drive, Hutton, whilst employed as a motor vehicle salesman at the then Bradshaw's of Marsh Lane, Preston. His mother was a civil servant working locally.

On leaving Preston Grammar School, Tony was employed at John Hawkins cotton manufacturing mill on Greenbank Street, Preston,



in the despatch office. It was here he met Irene Sadler and they were married on 15th June, 1942 at St. Andrew's Church, Ashton-on-Ribble, after which a cycling honeymoon was enjoyed in the Lake District.

He had been awaiting appointment to the local Constabulary as war broke out but joined the Royal Air Force instead. Tony completed thirty-seven missions over enemy territory and was then granted a break from operational flying to that of 'lighter duties' as a flight training instructor with the rank of Warrant Officer at Wymeswold airfield near Burton-on-the-Wolds, Leicestershire.

On that fateful day about 4pm on 7th October 1942, after take-off, it is suggested that the fabric covering of the wing stripped off and the aircraft became uncontrollable, crashing in a nearby village. Tony along with his colleagues Sgt. Barkel of Sunderland and Sgt. Jones of Manchester were all killed. At the family's request, Tony was buried at Burton-on-the-Wolds cemetery whilst the two others were returned home.

Irene who also joined the R.A.F. remarried after the war and had two children. She died in 2020 at the age of 98 years.
