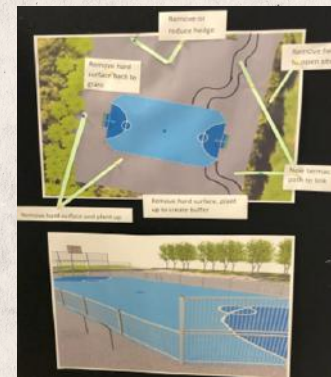
REMEMBRANCE SERVICE SATURDAY 11TH NOVEMBER 2023

ROAD SAFETY IN HUTTON

Following a public meeting in July, the Deputy Police and Crime Commissioner for Lancashire, Andy Pratt, has led a working meeting of police, highways engineers, Borough and Parish Councillors and residents' representatives to discuss what can be done to improve road safety particularly with respect to speeding.

Speed and traffic density data has been reviewed and actions agreed including additional signing, monitoring and enforcement. The future use of vehicle activated electronic speed signs (SPIDS) at strategic locations within the village will also be investigated.

Please always remember to respect speed limits, they are there for a reason in residential areas.
