


HUTTON PARISH COUNCIL

It was noted that the memorial bench supplied by Cllr Gilbert's family is to be installed next week

The door to the defib housing at the VH has rusted, a new door has been ordered as the best available option and should be available for installation soon.

The solar lighting on the new bus shelter appears to be working spasmodically – Cllr Gilbert will contact the suppliers to enquire as to whether the batteries (3 years old) are past their best.

It was mentioned that the humming noise from the National Grid Station at Howick Cross seems to be louder than usual.

VH security lighting has been installed by SRBC and seems to be quite effective. Conversations with the VH suggest that nothing more need be done at the moment other than monitoring its effect through this winter. General lighting on the car park including a black hole behind the building might need to be visited in the future.

Comment was made that the level of street lighting in Hutton appears to be at a lower level that in surrounding areas – enquiry will be made by the Clerk as to what policies are used to determine street lighting requirements.

An agenda item will be placed to the next meeting to discuss use of the new public car park opposite HGS and whether the current restrictions and use should be changed.
